

Character Descriptions For *Romeo and Juliet*

Romeo	Young son of Lord and Lady Montague. Age 16-17. He is a hot headed young man and rushes into things without thinking.
Juliet	Lord and Lady Capulet's daughter. She is 14 years old. She is a gentle girl and obedient to her parents.
Mercutio	Mercutio is akin to the Prince of Verona and a friend to Romeo. Mercutio is killed by Tybalt when Romeo tries to stop the two from fighting.
Paris	Paris is a young count and kin to the Prince. He wants to marry Juliet.
Tybalt	Tybalt is the nephew of Capulet and a cousin to Juliet. He is very headstrong and despises the Montague's. He kills Mercutio, and Tybalt is later killed by Romeo in revenge for Mercutio's death.
Benvolio	Benvolio is a friend to Romeo. He always tries to play the role of peacemaker by trying to stop the fighting between the Montague's and the Capulet's.
Nurse	The nurse is Juliet's friend and nursemaid. She raised Juliet, as was usually the custom of the time period for royal families. She is older and quite comical.
Friar Laurence	Friar Laurence marries Romeo and Juliet with the hope that the marriage will stop the feuding between both of their houses.
Montague	Montague is the leader of the house of Montague, and Romeo's father.
Lady Montague	Lady Montague is the wife of Montague.
Capulet	Capulet is the leader of the house of Capulet, and Juliet's father.
Lady Capulet	Lady Capulet is the wife of Capulet.
Balthasar	Balthasar is Romeo's servant. He tells Romeo that Juliet has died.
Escalus	Escalus is the Prince of Verona who tries to keep peace between the houses of Montague and Capulet. He banishes Romeo from Verona for the death of Tybalt.
Peter	Peter is the nurse's servant.
Sampson	Sampson is one of the servants to Capulet. He and Gregory start a fight at the beginning of the play with Abram, a servant of Montague.
Gregory	Gregory is one of the servants to Capulet. He and Sampson start a fight at the beginning of the play with Abram, a Servant of Montague.
Abram	Abram is one of the servants to Montague who gets into a fight with Sampson and Gregory.

<u>Billy Crocker</u> (Tenor, comic role)	Boards the ship without a ticket in pursuit of the girl he loves, Hope; and therefore, adopts a number of disguises
Hope Harcourt (Soprano)	A Debutante determined to marry Sir Evelyn Oakleigh to satisfy Mama Harcourt, even though she is in love with Billy
Reno Sweeney (Alto)	An evangelist turned nightclub singer. Old friend of Billy's - Patti LuPone type.
Sir Evelyn Oakleigh	A rich, English Gentleman
<u>Moon-Face</u> (Baritone)	Public Enemy #13, who wants to be 1st on the list
Bonnie Latour (Mezzo)	Public Enemy #1's companion
Elisha Whitney	Wall Street executive and Billy Crocker's boss
<u>Mrs. Harcourt</u>	Hope's haughty, overbearing mother
Bishop Henry Dobson	A minister
Ching and Ling	Two of Bishop Dobson's Chinese converts
Reno's "Angels,"	
Dancers and Crew Members	The chorus who is on the stage a lot, these are tap dancers, singers etc.
Drunk	The Drunk has no lines but is a walk on who can steal the show.
